The mission of Ronald McDonald House Charities of the Philadelphia Region is to create a community of comfort and hope for families with seriously ill children. The recent expansion of our Chestnut Street House increased guest family capacity nearly three-fold with the additional of an eight-story tower containing 104 new guest bedrooms and suites. Now we need artwork to fill our hallways and make our tower feel like home!

Art has the power to produce joy during tough times, to calm anxiety, to encourage mindfulness, and to create a sense of belonging.
