### DR. ALA STANFORD DR. AUDREY E. EVANS AWARD OF EXCELLENCE

Ronald McDonald House Charities Philadelphia Region

Dr. Ala Stanford is a national leader in health equity and a health care policy advisor. She is a trusted messenger and an advocate for vulnerable populations in the United States and globally. A practicing physician for over 20 years, Dr. Stanford is board certified by the American Board of Surgery in both pediatric and adult general surgery. She gained international recognition during the COVID-19 pandemic using the infrastructure of her pediatric surgery practice to create a grassroots organization focused on education, testing, contact tracing, and vaccination in communities devoid of access to care and resources. Her focus on those disproportionately impacted by COVID-19 saved lives. The Black Doctors COVID-19 Consortium directly served over 100,000 and countless others through the reach of their work. Dr. Stanford subsequently opened a Center for Health Equity in a Philadelphia zip code community with the lowest life expectancy, providing expert health care and improving health outcomes.

This award recognizes individuals who have made significant contributions to the health and well-being of children. Dr. Evans dedicated her career to helping children with cancer. In the medical community, she was a pioneer in the study and treatment of childhood cancers. She built a world-renowned pediatric cancer program at the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia. It was her dream and determination that led to the inception of the first Ronald McDonald House in Philadelphia in 1974.

## **DELLA CLARK** JIMMY MURRAY COMMUNITY LEADERSHIP AWARD

Della Clark's vision for minority entrepreneurship is not about counting the number of successful businesses but about making businesses count. Since 1992, Ms. Clark has brought this vision to fruition as President of The Enterprise Center – an organization at the forefront of the Greater Philadelphia region's entrepreneurial ecosystem, guided by the mission to cultivate and invest in minority entrepreneurs to inspire economic growth in communities. The Enterprise Center accomplishes this by accelerating the capacity of minority business enterprises to compete in any marketplace through business education, management support, access to capital, and procurement opportunities. Under her leadership, businesses have obtained more than \$870 million in contracts, \$209 million in financing, and created 3,221 jobs through the PA Minority Business Development Center.

This award honors individuals who are committed to improving the lives of families and their children through their community involvement. Jimmy Murray co-founded the world's first Ronald McDonald House in Philadelphia and was instrumental in the opening of Ronald McDonald Houses across the U.S. and around the world. He has remained deeply committed to children and families by serving on numerous non-profit boards and continues to act as an ambassador for RMHC of the Philly Region.

In addition to our two awardees, our event also celebrates the everyday heroes who demonstrate acts of volunteerism, philanthropy, and goodwill that align with our organizational mission: to support families on their children's medical journeys with a community of comfort and hope. Champions of Hope benefits the programs of RMHC Philly, so that families can stay close to their children while they receive life-saving treatment at nearby hospitals.

Skylar (above) and her family stayed at our Chestnut Street House for 19 days while she received surgery for a rare disease affecting her abdomen. **"The House took a huge weight off of our shoulders,"** her mom says. "Not having to worry about transportation, food, and extended lodging was a blessing."

The Witter Family (right) stayed at the House for 35 nights so their baby Greyson could receive lifesaving treatment for retinoblastoma. His mom shares, "I remember when we first walked in, it was like for a second we could breathe. **It was the best feeling ever.**"
