A Message from Our Chief Executive Officer



I am so pleased and proud to share that with the generous support of our community, Ronald McDonald House Charities of the Philadelphia Region (RMHC Philly) served more families than ever before in 2023. 1,965 families found comfort and relief during 3,097 stays which totaled a cumulative 46,955 room nights. The average stay was approximately two weeks long; however, about 15% of our families stayed more than 30 days. While families who stayed with us came to Philadelphia from all over the country and the world, approximately half of our guests were our neighbors traveling from across Pennsylvania and New Jersey.

Throughout our history, we have always taken every measure necessary to keep our families safe and comfortable. In 2019, that meant the opening of the Jill and Alan B. Miller Tower at the Chestnut Street House. That expansion increased our nightly capacity from 45 to 127 available rooms at that House location. We could not know that the years following our ribbon cutting would include a global pandemic, but throughout that difficult chapter we continued to provide lodging, meals, transportation, and vital social support services to every guest family who stayed with us. Following the height of the pandemic, we learned what the new normal is for RMHC Philly and—with 147 available rooms across our two Philadelphia Houses—2023 was the first year in which we could operate at our full capacity all year long.

Serving 147 families every day kept us busy, but in the spirit of our founders, Dr. Audrey Evans and Jimmy Murray, our staff and volunteers rose to the occasion, always keeping our guest families at the center of everything we do. We even successfully piloted two new programs as part of the Dr. Audrey Evans Center for Family Support Services—an Education and Tutoring Program and In-House Camp.

We were thrilled to have a professional educator join the staff, who works hand-in-hand with a team of volunteers with valid teaching certificates, to tutor both patient children and their siblings during their stay. In 2023, this team delivered more than 300 hours of tutoring sessions. The program allows for flexibility when medical appointment schedules change, and parents have expressed countless times how grateful they are for this educational support.

In-House Camp, a day camp unique to RMHC Philly, included six weeks of summertime fun for patients and their families. Each week had a theme and included special activities and field trips. Families were able to explore and enjoy Philadelphia with outings to Please Touch Museum, Adventure Aquarium, The Franklin Institute, and a Phillies game, among others. The culmination of In-House Camp even included a family carnival complete with jugglers, games, prizes, and face painting.

In addition to the work we do in our two Philadelphia Ronald McDonald Houses, our core programs extend beyond the walls of the House to include Family Rooms at CHOP and St. Christopher's, Ronald McDonald Camp (RMC), and the Ronald McDonald Care Mobile. Our Family Rooms provided comfort within the hospital walls for 10,000 visitors this year and served 20,500 cups of coffee. RMC welcomed 139 campers to in-person camp and 24 campers to virtual camp. The Care Mobile provided 1,800 free dental exams to under- and uninsured families in North Philadelphia and visited 52 schools.

We learned so much from 2023 and because of you, as we look forward to our 50th Anniversary in 2024, we feel more confident than ever in our ability to serve the needs of the 147 guest families we serve every day. The work that we do is impossible without friends like you. In 2023, 10,438 donors came together to fund our mission and our volunteers served a cumulative 30,575 hours to help deliver our mission.

Thank you for being part of our community of comfort and hope and enabling us to serve more families than ever in 2023. We hope you will help us celebrate our 50th Anniversary in 2024 and beyond by continuing to keep our families and our Houses in your heart.

Through the Dr. Audrey E. Evans Center for Family Support Services, our team provides comprehensive supportive assistance, including family activities, tutoring for children, and emotional, financial, and family resources that foster wellbeing.

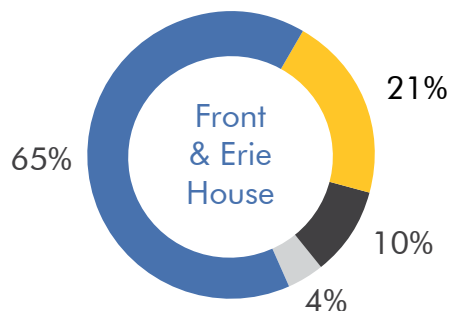
“We needed an affordable, long-term place to stay with all the necessary accommodations, especially reliable transportation to and from the hospital,” shared his mother, Mary.

Top Hospitals Served by Room Nights

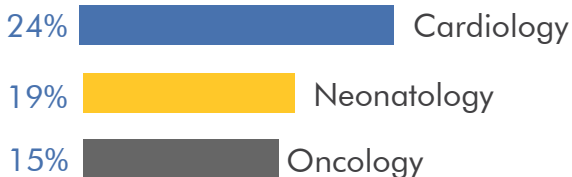

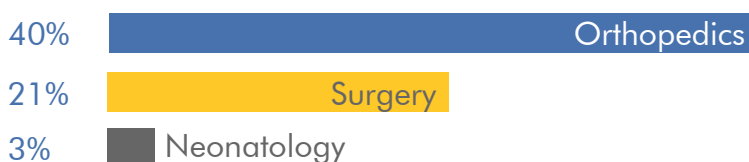

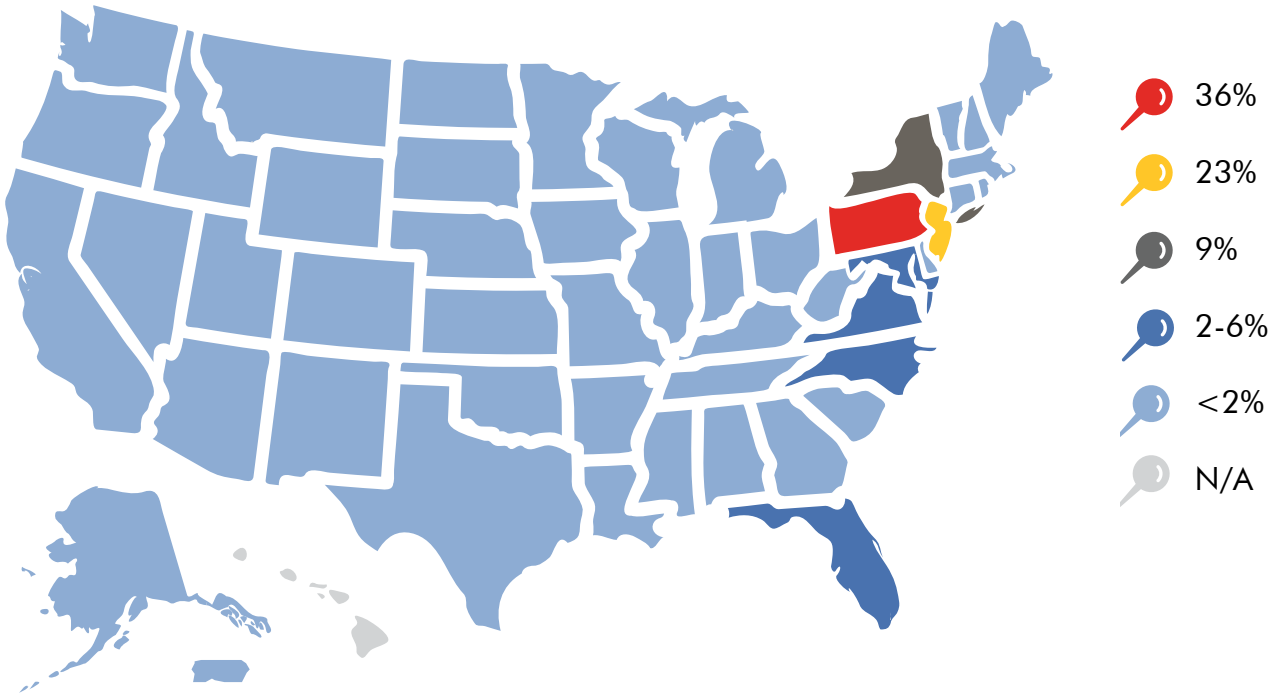

Ronald McDonald Family Rooms



Our Ronald McDonald Family Rooms, two at the Children’s Hospital of Philadelphia—one serving the Oncology Unit and one at the Seashore House—and one serving the Critical Care Unit of St. Christopher’s Hospital for Children, extend the comfort and support of our Houses into the hospital by offering quiet and comfortable respite spaces where families can rest and regroup away from the bedside.

Due to COVID restrictions, we had to close our three Ronald McDonald Family Rooms in March 2020. In 2022, we reopened our two Family Rooms at CHOP the Family Room at St. Christopher’s reopened for families as well.



Ronald McDonald Care Mobile



The Ronald McDonald Care Mobile, operated in partnership with St. Christopher’s Foundation for Children, provides comprehensive and continuous oral healthcare to children in North Philadelphia. There is a critical need in this area, and the Care Mobile removes barriers so that children who most need dental and oral health care and treatment can access care and prevent their oral health conditions from worsening. There is currently no other program that provides such services to the youngest residents of North Philadelphia. We visit patients at Head Start communities, early childhood centers, elementary schools, and shelters. The Ronald McDonald Care Mobile is a Dental Home: it provides an ongoing relationship between the dentist and the patient in a continually accessible, family-centered way.

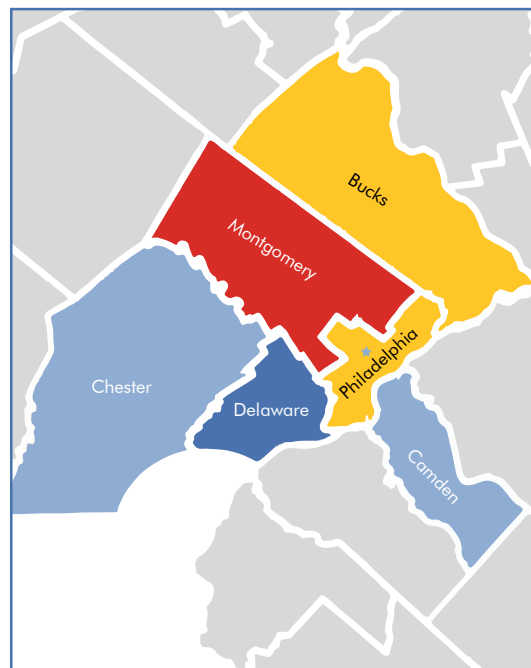

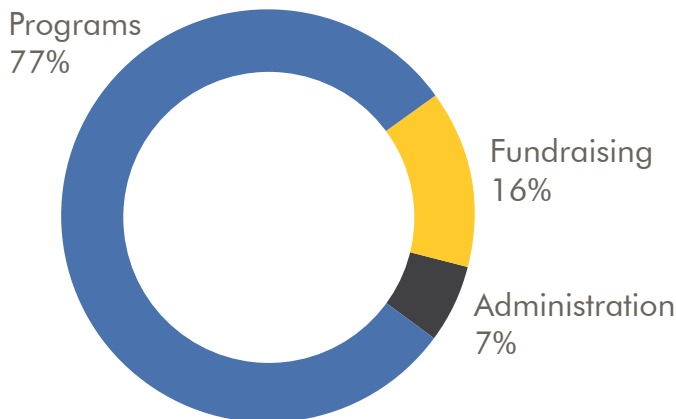

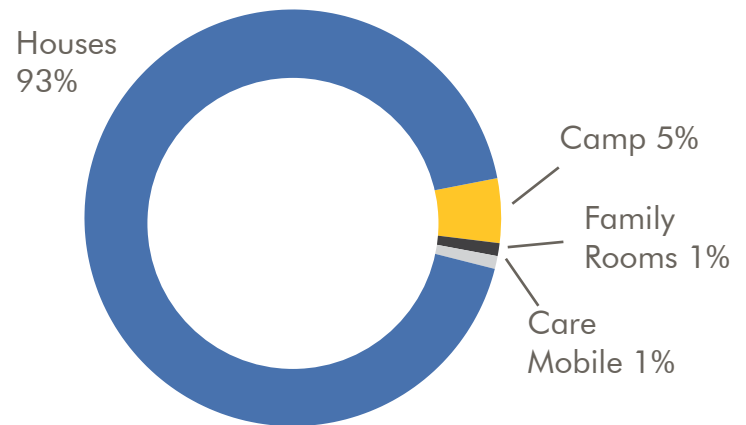

How Does McDonald's Help?



McDonald's played a vital role at the inception of the Philadelphia Ronald McDonald House, the first Ronald McDonald House in the world, which opened on October 15, 1974. Since then, our local McDonald's Owner/Operators have remained committed to supporting our programs.

RMHC of the Philadelphia Region is a locally funded and operated 501(c)(3) non-profit organization. The 220 McDonald's Restaurants in the region (including the greater Philadelphia area and Southern New Jersey) provide 6% of our annual operating budget. This funding is provided through the Round-Up for RMHC program at restaurant registers, Happy Meal and Shamrock Shake sale proceeds, and other promotions and annual initiatives.

McDonald's Owner/Operators of the Greater Philadelphia Region may also provide additional support through:

- Participation as members of our Board of Directors.
- Working with McDonald's vendors and suppliers to raise money and awareness through promotional and fundraising events.
- Encouraging their employees to volunteer at the House.

Beyond the support provided by McDonald's Owner/Operators and crew members, the majority of our annual budget comes from the generosity of individuals, corporations, and foundations.
