## DR. HOLLY HEDRICK DR. AUDREY E. EVANS AWARD OF EXCELLENCE

Dr. Holly Hedrick is a pediatric and fetal surgeon at Children's Hospital of Philadelphia (CHOP) and a global leader in fetal surgery. As one of the first female surgeons in her field, she specializes in complex procedures such as the separation of conjoined twins and treatment of congenital diaphragmatic hernia (CDH).

Dr. Hedrick leads CHOP's CDH program, which cares for the largest number of patients worldwide, and helped create the Pulmonary Hypoplasia Program—offering long-term, multidisciplinary care for children with underdeveloped lungs. She has also led international efforts to advance fetal therapies, including clinical trials and groundbreaking surgeries like the removal of a heart tumor before birth.



Respected for her compassionate approach, Dr. Hedrick is a trailblazer who echoes Dr. Audrey Evans' dedication. She hopes her legacy includes exceptional care and a meaningful, lasting impact on patients and families.
